The Rousseau PTO needs you to help make this school year a success! Please consider volunteering your time and talent, whether it be an hour spreading mulch or a year chairing a committee, because we simply can't do the things we do without you. (And that'd be a real bummer!) And, as an added bonus, you might just meet a few new friends along the way!

- After School Classes** - Help plan and organize after school classes for the fall and spring semesters, collect student registration forms, and compile class rosters. Most work takes place at the beginning of each semester.
- Bicycle Rodeo** - Help with bicycle related activities after school on Thursday, April 15.
- Books & Beyond** - Record reading sheets and distribute prizes to students on Fridays during February and March.
- Family Night Series** - Help with the planning, organizing, setting up, or tearing down of the quarterly family events, such as Family Reading Night on Thursday, January 28 and Family Fun Night on Friday, May 7.
- Fish Tank** - Help maintain order in the fish tank, typically by feeding the fish and cleaning the tank.
- Friday Folders** - Sort and pack materials to be sent home each Friday, or the last day of the school week, for your child's classroom. Requires approximately 30 minutes each week, and may be done at your convenience, including the lunch hour! Opportunities to alternate weeks with another parent may be available.
- Gift Sales** - Help distribute gift sale orders after school on Wednesday, October 21.
- Hospitality** - Provide food for the staff during the school year, especially during parent-teacher conferences in October and February and staff appreciation week in April. (Multiple donations are not required.)
- Landscaping** - Help with the cleanup and maintenance of the school grounds as needed throughout the year.
- Media Center** - Help Mrs. Hughes with various tasks, such as shelving books. May be done at your convenience.
- Photography** - Document the school year by taking photographs at activities and events.
- Room Parents** - Provide store-bought treats for your child's classroom parties on Friday, November 13 and Friday, February 12. (Attendance at the parties is not required.)
- Scholastic Book Fair** - Help with the set-up, sales, or tear-down of the book fair that will be held from 3:30 to 7:30 p.m. on Monday, November 30, Tuesday, December 1, and Wednesday, December 2.
- School History** - Help archive and organize school documents and pictures from years past.
- School Pictures** - Help sort and distribute individual picture orders in the fall and class picture orders in the spring.
- Silent Auction Book Baskets** - Help coordinate and collect donations for the silent auction that will be held in conjunction with Family Reading Night on Thursday, January 28.
